Eka Permanasari ST., PhD sudah berkecimpung di dunia riset dan professional dalam bidang Arsitektur dan Urban Design. Dr. Permanasari memiliki pengalaman bekerja, mengajar dan meneliti di Indonesia dan Australia. Topik riset dan pembelajarannya menyangkut isuisu social, penciptaan ruang sebagai implementasi praktek kekuasaan dalam Arsitektur dan Urban Design, serta penggunaan ruang dalam konteks keseharian. Termasuk didalamnya penelitian dalam bidang arsitektur yang menyimbolkan kekuasaan, politik dalam ruang publik, perumahan dan pemukiman kota, gated community, shopping malls, hingga kajian wilayah kota. Publikasi Dr Permanasari lebih banyak melihat isu-isu perkotaan dan bagaimana hal tersebut mempengaruhi keseharian, penggunaan dan pemaknaan ruang publik.

Selain bergelut dalam bidang riset, bekerjasama dengan Pemprov DKI, Dr Permanasari menangani beberapa proyek strategis antara lain pembuatan Masterplan Giant Sea Wall di Jakarta, membuat konsep dan rancangan 6 Pilot Projects Ruang Publik Terpadu Ramah Anak (RPTRA), Kajian LRT Jakarta dan Studi Bandara Ali Sadikin. Kebijakan public yang diruuskan bersama Pemprov DKI adalah antara lain Pergub 196 Tahun 2015 tentang Pengelolaan RPTRA.

Saat ini Dr. Permanasari menjabat sebagai Wakil Dekan Akademik di Fakultas Teknologi dan Design. Selain mnejadi wakil dekan, dalam keseharian Dr. Permanasari bekerja sebagai Senior Lecturer di Program Studi Arsitektur. Topik mata kuliah yang selaras dengan keahlian: Studio Perancangan Arsitektur, Studio Perancangan Lingkungan, Studio Urban Design, Teori Arsitektur, Teori Urban Design, Kolonialisme dan Poskolonialisme dan Arsitektur Vernakular.
